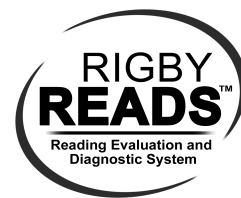

- Your child is curious and is expanding interests at a growing pace. Tell your child's teacher or the school librarian about the child's interests, curiosities, and independent reading level. They will be able to supply a list of books that are on those topics and that your child will be able to read successfully.
- Your child can be a more successful reader by reading more. Be sure reading is a fun and interesting time for your child. Set aside a time for you and your child to share ideas from stories and books you have read.
- Your child is at a very important point in becoming a reader. Some students get away from reading at this age. You can play an important part in helping your child become a life-long reader. Finding books at the appropriate reading level that deal with your child's interests is a good way to lead your child to more reading.
